

Victim Theft Pending Investigation

Report for Incident 2018-001823, Theft, document created on 5/26/2018 @ 07:37:49

On May 25th, 2018, I Deputy Vicente with the Union County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to [REDACTED] in Anna IL. At approximately 0800 I arrived and met [REDACTED] the owner of the missing item at his driveway. [REDACTED] stated that he believes his 2017 XP 900 Polaris Ranger VIN number 3NSRTE871HG964142 was taken Tuesday May 22nd, 2018 between the hours of 1715 and 2015. [REDACTED] states that the reason he did not contact the police sooner is because he believed that a family member parked it in the garage where it is stored at night. I asked Mr. [REDACTED] if his grand kids may have taken it for a joy ride, wrecked it and may not have told him, [REDACTED] does not believe so. I also asked [REDACTED] if he may have told a friend they could borrow it whenever they'd like, he stated no. I

asked if [REDACTED] takes the keys out of the Polaris or if they leave the keys in the ignition, he stated they do leave the keys in the ignition. I got a description and also the VIN number of the Polaris. I left [REDACTED] a statement to fill out, I also asked [REDACTED] if he could try to find pictures of the Polaris to attach to the report and assured him the Sheriff's Office will keep an eye out for it. I asked him if by chance he was driving around and saw it to contact the Union County Sheriff's Office and that we would run the VIN number and handle it so he doesn't put himself at risk.
