

**UC1804-30-040****Investigative Report****4/25/18**

The purpose of this report is to document the investigation into the death of Mickle Brock on April 25, 2018.

On the above date I Detective Bart Hileman was sent to the address of [REDACTED] in rural Union County to a report of a possible suicide.

On my arrival I spoke with Union County Sheriff's Deputy Josh Schildknecht who had received the original call, and had arrived prior to me. Also on scene was Beth Myers with the Union County Coroners Office, and Matt Deschamps with the Illinois State Police Crime Scene Services.

Deputy Schildknecht led me to a out building located on the south side of the residence. There I observed a male subject hanging from a wire cable. The subject I knew to be Mickle Brock, Brock was deceased.

Brock had taken a wire cable, secured one end to a rafter of the building, and the other end around his neck. It appeared that Mickle had stood in the seat of a riding lawn mover to fasten the one end of the wire cable to the rafter. Footwear impression left on the seat appeared to match the shoes that Mickle was wearing.

I spoke with Brocks girlfriend identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that sometime after 12:30 pm this day Mickle went out to the garage to look for parts to repair a mower for a person that had been there earlier in the day.

█████ stated that she knew Mickle was in the garage because she heard the air compressor running. A little while later, █████ stated that she heard her dog barking. She went out of the house (█████ residence) and saw that her dog (who was tied up on a chain) had gotten stuck in the underpinning of her, and Mickle's trailer (Which was on the north side of the house).

After freeing the dog, █████ stated that she wondered why Mickle did not come over to get the dog or help her. █████ stated that she called his name several times and received no response. █████ stated that she called his cellphone, but received no answer.

Tarr stated that she was nervous and looked towards the garage where she observed only part of Mickel. █████ said that she noticed his arm was down to his side, and not moving. █████ then called █████ (Mickle's mother and told her she thought something was wrong with Mickle, and asked her to come home. █████ was at the Kroger store in Anna ).

█████ stated that when █████ pulled into the driveway, she began honking the horn, and yelling at █████ to call for help.

█████ said that both she and █████ tried to cut Mickle down, but could not find any tools to cut the cable.

█████ stated that Mickle had been depressed with the possibility that he may have cancer, he had surgery on April 11th 2018 in Carbondale Illinois, and was awaiting results from testing.

█████ also stated that Mickle was a patient of Dr. Katrina Tripp at Rural Health for Mental Health issues. █████ said that Mickle had been placed into Choate Mental Health center in the past for mental health problem. █████ further stated that Mickle had been suicidal in the past.

After Crime Scene was finished, Mickle was cut down from the rafters, and the body was turned over to the Union County Coroner's Office.

The body of Mickle Brock was transported to the Hileman Funeral Home in Jonesboro Illinois where a Postmortem exam and collection kit was conducted. The collected evidence was turned over to me where I placed it into evidence with the sheriff's office.
