Suspect Child Abduction Referred to S/A on 5/19/2019

Report for Incident 2019-002212, Walk In,

On 05/19/2019 I Sergeant Jeffrey Stroehlein met with Theresa Bailey in the lobby of the Union County Sheriff's Office in reference to a child custody issue. Theresa stated her ex husband, Airn Bailey, was refusing to bring their child, [REDACTED] back after his scheduled visitation. Per the court order in 10-D-12 out of Union County, the child exchange is to take place inside the building at the Ullin, IL Police Department. Theresa stated there is never anyone in the building so they go to the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office for the exchange. She showed me text messages between she and Airn starting at 1530 hours on the above mentioned date. In the conversation, Airn states, "we wont be there till Friday for summer break she got plans for camping and going to see Aladdin movie." Theresa replied, "You don't get summer break you better be there at 4 pm." Airn later replies, "Nope I always get my summer break u will get ur weekends. Nothings changing that."

Theresa told me she has allowed Airn to have their daughter the previous summers but it states in the paperwork if both parties do not agree, they are to revert back to the court documents which gives Theresa custody during the summer months. Theresa stated Airn is behind on child support and she told him in either January or February of 2019 he would not get their daughter for the summer months.

I then contacted Airn via telephone and asked him what was going on. He said he always get their daughter during summer breaks. I read to him line 2 where it states, "The parties understand that they can agree to modify this schedule, but unless both of them agree on the terms, there is no modification." He said he was not going to bring his daughter back because of having her in the past years. I advised him he could be found in contempt of court for violating the order and he said he was going to do what he was going to do.

It should be noted Theresa attempted to make this report with the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office, she could not remember the name of the deputy she spoke with. She said the deputy told her since the order was written in Union County, he could not take the complaint and sent her to our office.

I have attached a copy of 10-D-12 with this report.
