Suspect Assault Administratively Closed on 2/08/2021

Report for Incident 2021-000451, Assault

On 02/08/2021 at approximately 0913hrs I Deputy Bridges with the Union County Sheriffs Office responded to 80 Knupp School Lane in Anna Illinois to the report of a resident being verbally aggressive towards staff. 80 Knupp School Lane is a Community Integrated Living Facility.

I Deputy Bridges arrive on scene and make contact with Cody A. Williams (DOB [REDACTED]) Cody is resident at the facility. Cody says he got upset because a staff member Tammy J. Griffin (DOB [REDACTED]) was not getting him his cigarettes fast enough. Cody was very upset and saying that he did not want to go back to prison. I Deputy Bridges calmed Cody down by speaking with him.

Tammy says she heard Cody express words that were threatening, so she was instructed to call Law Enforcement. Tammy was not withholding cigarettes from Cody, Cody was being impatient. Cody the apologizes to Tammy and the other staff members.

No charges are being filed, the purpose of this report is to document the incident.
